

2020 Rules:

RULES: The following rules shall be interpreted by the President and or Officers of the His and hers bass club. All interpretations and decisions are final.

TEAMS: Teams must be consisted of one Male gender and One Female gender to participate. All contestants, when required must have valid Oklahoma fishing licenses.

MEMBERSHIP AND ENTRY FEES: All contestants must be a member of His and Hers Bass club to participate. Yearly membership Fees are \$125 per team to include TBF/FLW affiliation. Tournament entry fees are \$65, with \$10 going to big bass. \$5 going to end of year classic. Memberships of teams consisting of youth members may have different cost of membership discuss with club officers prior to submitting.

SAFETY: Life jackets must be worn while on plane, All Federal State and local Laws must be obeyed.

BOATS: Any boat 16'minimum length that has a working aerated live well.

FISHING & TACKLE: Artificial lures only (pork style baits allowed), Only 1 rod and reel at a time in the water per person, No trolling. All fishing must be done from the contestant's boat.

Substitutions and Absences: Each team will be allowed to sub no more than two events per season, Or Fish alone two events per season, Or the combination of 1 substitute an event, and 1 fish alone an event per season.

TAKE OFF&WEIGH IN: Take off and Weigh in Time to be determined by Tournament director and or President. His and hers will be an "Honors System" club for takeoff. Meaning any Team may put in at any Public boat ramp on the lake being fished but are not allowed to begin fishing until the official "Take off Time." Weigh in will be conducted at the Official Launch ramp for that tournament at the described times for that tournament. Teams will only be allowed to trailer 1 time before putting in. None after putting in, unless decided upon in advanced of each tournament by Director and or President. Late Penalties will be applied at .25 pounds per minute up to 15 min. After 15 min team weight will be disqualified for that day.

RULES CHANGES & AMENDMENTS: Any and all rules can be subject to change any time during the year at either the meeting or weigh in as long as there is at minimum **75%** of membership present. Changes will be then voted on by club membership and passed if **60%** of present teams agree or vote yes.

EMERGENCIES & MECHANICAL ISSUES: In the event that any team has Mechanical Issues or an Emergency Situation arise It will be allowable to have a club officer (preferably) or another contestant in the His and Hers tournament weigh in their fish. If another contestant is used it is preferable to notify by cell phone a club officer in advance of weigh in.

SCORING: 5 fish limit 14" Largemouth and Smallmouth bass. 12" limit on spotted bass. (State/lakes Rules have precedent) Individual tournament length limits will be discussed during the pre-tournament meetings if required. Scoring: 1st place will receive (1) point, 2nd place will receive (2) points etc. Teams fishing but not weighing any fish will receive last team weighing fish points place plus (2) points. Teams not fishing will receive last team weighing fish points place plus (5) points. AAOY will be determined by the team with the "lowest" points total at the end of the year. All teams will get (1) throw out tournament being their lowest placing

tournament. Dead fish penalty will be .25lb, will also be applied to your Big Bass total if your big bass is dead.

CLUB OFFICIALS: Officers of His and Hers Bass club will be responsible for conducting all club related business and up keep of Internet sites, financial Accounts, Club rosters and meeting minutes. Volunteering club members May assist with meetings, weigh in's and Tackle shows. Any club officer upon relinquishing his or her duties as an officer of His and hers bass club will return or provide all His and hers bass club property including Internet site passwords, check books and or records to newly appointed officials of His and hers bass club.

CLASSIC QUALIFICATION: Teams must fish (3) tournaments to be eligible to participate in the end of year classic. For every tournament missed by a qualifying team that team's entry fee for the classic will be increased by \$5 to go towards the classic fund. Classic points count towards End of year standings.
